Footnotes

CLEMENS BROOK dueled for the lead from the outside, gained a slight advantage in mid-stretch, drifted out late and held gamely. TOUCH OF ELEGANCE was away alertly to duel for the lead from between rivals and gave way grudgingly late. JUST HAVE'N FUN was never far back, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with a steady bid. CHAMPALI LACE dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. STRATEGIC PATIENCE lagged early, angled out approaching the stretch and failed to threaten. CHEESE DANISH bobbled at the break, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. OPENING BUZZ raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and lacked the needed rally.
