### Footnotes

MINGUN'S MARK lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and held off the closing SPEEDY TOM to prevail. SPEEDY TOM was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and was gaining on the winner late. SPICY FORMULA chased the leaders from the inside, dropped back slightly after going a half and came back to finish with good energy. CHRIS GO was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. TWILIGHT MEMO was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from between foes and gave way through the final furlong. KINGLEDO went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going a half. NOT JUST ANY PETE was fractious at the gate, off slow, raced wide through the turn and trailed throughout.
