Footnotes

CYBER BELL stalked the leader from the outside, moved up to engage JUDDAW with a furlong to run, exchanged bumps with that rival through the final sixteenth and proved best. JIDDAW pressed the pace from between rivals, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter, responded when challenged by the winner in mid-stretch, exchanged bumps with that foe late and gave way grudgingly. MORE WINE MON lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with a solid rally. PASSION LIVES HERE showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, moved inside nearing the sixteenth pole and finished evenly late. SNOW ON THE RIVER was never far back while racing along the inside and gradually gave way. ENUMERATOR was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going three-quarters. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the bumping between CYBERBELL and JIDDAW through the final yards and after reviewing the films concluded JIDDAW had initiated the contact and made no change.
