PASSION LIVES HERE was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out in mid-stretch, gained command soon after and drew clear late. PRINCE GIDDYUP showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. CUTIE'S SHAMUS chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole and failed to sustain that rally in the drive. BOISE CREEK hopped at the start, raced off the rail into the stretch, moved between rivals late and finished with a belated bid. BUCKLE sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, turned back the bid of CUTIE'S SHAMUS nearing the five-sixteenths marker, re-cleared and gave way through the final furlong. MR MAHAL broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. BRAND KNEW hopped at the start, showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
