Footnotes

TOUGH TIKE set the pressured pace racing three deep, handily cut clear entering the stretch and scored easily. GIRLS NITE steadily advanced on the turn, split horses at the top of the lane and finished well. TRAVEL THE SUN settled saving ground, made a middle move closing fast on the turn, but flattened out. L. P. L.'S SPECIAL offered a late rally circling five wide on the turn, and posted a mild bid. ANNIE'S BOU PEEP failed to respond. COURT RECORD pressed from between horses, came up empty in the upper stretch and faded fast. A. J.'S LIL SIS steadily dropped back. DAZEE'S COUNTES was outrun. KITTY MAC COOL sent hard to press the pace, was used up in mid turn and stopped.
