RAISE THE BLUFF dueled for the lead racing two wide, shook clear entering the stretch, was ridden out to increase his advantage and scored as the rider pleased. SWITZERLAND dueled for the lead racing along the inside, was no match for the winner, but finished willingly to clearly prove second best. EAGLETORR settled saving ground, angled out to make a late rally, and was along in time to earn the show. COASTAL KING chased the pace racing four wide, but weakened during the drive and gave way. SO WHAT was slow into stride, came five wide to make a belated rally, but was left with too much to do. CALENDAR ISSUE showed little. ROYAL BRASS contended racing between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. ANOTHER QUICKIE was through early.
