CLEARPOINT was bumped at the start, lagged early, moved outside through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and was up in the final yards. PERHAPS PERHAPS pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, gained a slight edge with a furlong to run but could not resist the winner late. RUN TIN TIN was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way after going seven furlongs. A. LURIE GIRL was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane, lacked racing room nearing the sixteenth pole, angled out and finished with good energy. PETE'S GLORY GIRL chased the leaders from the inside, was rank to rate through the back-stretch and gave way into the lane. TEACHER'S RULE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and failed to rally. PEPE LE FEU raced off the leaders from between foes and gradually weakened. WARREN'S DREAMING raced off the pacesetters from the inside and weakened after going a half.
