DR. BOB stalked the leaders from the outside, responded to steady left handed urging and proved best through the final yards. BRITE CITY LIGHTS was hustled along to open a clear lead early, saved ground while setting the pace, turned back the bid of PRIMO GIFT nearing the seven-sixteenths marker and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. PRIMO GIFT was bumped at the start, moved up soon after to vie for the lead with BRITE CITY LIGHTS, could not get by that rival in the drive and also gave way to his stable-mate while finishing with good courage. TURN TO FLY lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, steadied into the lane, angled outside and finished with good energy. PETESVILLE was bumped at the start and steadied, angled outside approaching the stretch and failed to menace. HUBBLE CAST was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and did not threaten thereafter. BANDALITO HOMBRE was bumped at the start, showed brief speed and gave way. KICKBOX was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten.
