SHE'S ALL SILK was away alertly to stalk the pace of NANCY PERKINS from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run, opened a clear lead and was all out to hold off the closing SUN CITY to prevail. SUN CITY raced off the pacesetters early, angled outside nearing the eighth pole and was quickly gaining on the winner through the final yards. SHANSEY was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. ECLATANTE showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and found her best stride late. NANCY PERKINS broke sharply to take command at once, opened a clear lead before a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, maintained a safe margin into mid-stretch and weakened. CHEL SEA N raced off the leaders from the outside and failed to rally. NINA WIN lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
