**Footnotes**

ROYAL SHRINE was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run and held off the closing WIN PHOTOS WILL DO to prevail. WIN PHOTOS WILL DO lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and was gaining on the winner late to just miss. SEND SILVER stalked the pace of NICK'S GOLD from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the five-sixteenths marker, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and gave way to the closers through the final yards. NICK'S GOLD sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going three-quarters. MAMOONYA was fractious at the gate, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. DAVIDAARONNATHANNE raced off the pacesetters from between rivals and failed to rally. ARMED SERVICE was off a step slow, raced far wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. BEBE CHRISSEY raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. NEWAUKUM CREEK raced off the pacesetters early, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths pole and weakened thereafter.
