KIND OF NAUGHTY sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by STEPHANIE PLUM in mid-stretch, vied with that rival through a hard drive and gamely prevailed. STEPHANIE PLUM was never far back while racing from the outside, moved up to engage the winner in mid-stretch, vied with that rival and just missed in a game effort. MAGGIE'S SPECIAL raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, reached a contending position into the lane but failed to gain late. RONDA ROCKS was off a step slow, raced wide through both turns and did not threaten. BETTER TO BE LUCKY showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. ENGLISH LACE was away alertly to chase the winner from the outside and weakened after going a half.
