SILVER SCREEN GIRL saved ground setting the pressured pace, opened a clear lead nearing the eighth pole and held a safe advantage to the wire. TAMARACK BAY unhurried early, rallied four-wide into the stretch and finished fast. SECONDARY SCHOOL prompted the issue while racing three-wide and held on well for the show. R C GANGSTER steadied in tight along the inside entering the first turn, then was allowed to settle in stride, swung out for the drive, but lacked a response. STRIKES NO SPARES showed little in a dull effort. CONSTANTLY disputed the pace for six furlongs while racing two-wide and tired.
