WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when set down for the drive and held gamely to the wire. HE'S FLYIN HOME lacked early speed, moved between foes nearing the quarter, cut back inside in mid-stretch and was gaining on the winner late. OVERTIME VICTORY lagged early, raced wide through the second turn and finished full of run. IMMIGRATION was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. SNOW ON THE RIVER raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and failed to rally. WHITNEY BRIDGE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders and gradually weakened.
