JADE GREEN saved ground stalking the pace, angled out entering the stretch and was up in the final sixteenth to win going away. SABERTOOTH saved ground setting the pace in hand, responded when asked, was unable to resist the winner, but was clearly second best. DIGLETT was between horses early, angled to the inside nearing the quarter pole and was making up some ground late. JUMRON WON reserved off the early pace while racing four-wide, continued along the outside while offering a mild bid nearing the quarter pole, but was unable to sustain his rally. POKER BRAD raced in the middle of the pack, but lacked a response when called on. TACTICAL ALLUSION was prominently placed while racing three-wide and tired after six furlongs. DUKE'S TUNE was outrun. ADMIRAL'S CAP was forwardly placed for five furlongs and gave way.
