STAR VALLEY STAR stalked the pace racing along the inside, came three wide to make his bid, opened clear nearing the furlong marker and was kept to task to maintain a safe advantage. MILITARY DEPUTY settled racing in hand, came four wide to make his bid, and finished willingly to earn the place. GET CONNECTED was allowed to settle into stride, came three wide to make his bid from between horses, but found his best stride too late. SACRED SENOR hopped at the start to get away slowly, rushed to contention three wide, forged a narrow lead leaving the second turn, but flattened during the drive and gave way. WAILEA WARRIOR was unhurried early, came three wide to make a belated gain, but only passed his tiring rivals. OB'SBABY B contended racing along the inside, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out. KEYS A DON JUAN was away alertly to set the pressured pace, but was headed leaving the second turn and stopped.
