PLAIN JAMES stalked the pace racing along the inside, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled out to continue the rally, wore down BLACK JACK JOE and steadily drew clear. MY FRIEND LUIS was away alertly, settled racing in hand and angled in to save ground, split horses to make his bid, finished full of run but was unable to reach the winner. BLACK JACK JOE rushed to the lead to set the pressured pace, weakened during the drive, but had enough left to hold the show. WOW NOW pressed the pace racing two wide, but flattened out during the drive and gave way. CASTLE PINES was slow into stride, came five wide to make a mild rally, but failed to seriously threaten. INITIAL REACTION was unhurried early, got through to make a belated gain, but passed only his tiring rivals. MAN OF THE HOUSE broke a step slow, angled out to be clear racing five wide but showed little. ORE BRAIN attended the pace racing along the inside, angled out entering the turn racing three wide, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. COUNTRY COP was hustled along racing four wide for a half and tired.
