Footnotes

FACE YOUR FEAR was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters, moved outside through the turn, reached the leaders with a a furlong to run, vied with PRAISE A NATIVE through the final yards and proved best. PRAISE A NATIVE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid in mid-stretch but could not match strides with the winner late. PLAY FOR DOUBLE pressed the pace from the inside, angled out into the stretch, cut back inside nearing the eighth pole and finished willingly. BE THERE JOE was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way in the drive. CAMP PENDLETON showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane, checked nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly late. ONCE raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and failed to menace. MCGUFFIN lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. OUR TAIL WIN raced off the leaders from the outside, lugged out through the turn and did not threaten. The rider of CAMP PENDLETON lodged an objection against PLAY FOR DOUBLE concerning the checking of her mount at the eighth pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
