BEA SASPRI was off slow, began to advance from the outside through the turn, bumped with EYES ON US nearing the three-sixteenths pole, responded to steady encouragement, reached the leaders with a sixteenth to run and was going away late. MISS MONY BAGGZ was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command into the lane, opened a clear margin but could not resist the winner late. BOOBY TRAP was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. EYES ON US was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, bumped with the winner into the lane and finished evenly thereafter. CHIPS INDY SALSA was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gave way in the drive. JIVA broke sharply then was hustled along to open a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after a half. CASTLE TEMPEST raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened. MYBRIGHT EYES bobbed at the start, saved ground into the lane and did not reach contention. MENDEL'S LAW raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and dropped far back in the drive.
