Footnotes

CASCADE CORONA dueled from the inside with LASTING CODE, shook off that one entering the stretch, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of HANSELINA, and prevailed following a prolonged drive. HANSELINA stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out and bumped AUNT SOPHIE near the half mile marker, came four wide to make her bid, finished well and was getting to the winner late. AUNT SOPHIE settled racing in hand while three deep, was bumped and checked with a half mile to run, angled in on the second turn, came again but found her best stride too late. LASTING CODE dueled for the lead racing two wide, weakened during the drive, and gave way. THEKINGSQUEEN settled saving ground, was caught in tight and steadied leaving the three-eighths pole, and went evenly thereafter. CALLDARA chased the pace racing three wide, but faltered from between horses in the upper stretch and dropped out. DEFREERE'S IMAGE showed little in a dull effort. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping incident involving HANSELINA and AUNT SOPHIE near the half mile marker, and into the incident involving THEKINGSQUEEN and AUNT SOPHIE leaving the three-eighths pole, but found insufficient interference to warrant a change to the order of finish.
