JAZZ CONCERT bobbed at the break, recovered quickly to duel for the lead from between foes, bumped with COUP DE Foudre in mid-stretch, vied with that rival until nearing the sixteenth marker and drew clear late. COUP DE Foudre duelled for the lead from between rivals, bumped with the winner nearing the eighth pole and could not stay with that rival in the closing yards. POLISH VODKA broke in, was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out with a furlong to run and finished evenly. TRIPSY was off slow, raced wide into the stretch and finished with some late run. J JACQUELINE was bumped at the start, raced far wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SERAMOVA hopped at the start, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace. CARBON RIVER was void of early speed, saved ground into the stretch and was not a factor. DOOZYBURG was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and stopped after a quarter.
