SHOULDABEENMAIZEY was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage COCO'SPRIVATELABEL with a furlong to run and proved best over that rival in a stiff drive. COCO'SPRIVATELABEL was bumped at the start then hustled along, reached the leaders nearing the eighth pole, vied with the winner through the prolonged drive and just missed. BABY BASKET broke awkwardly, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished with good courage. SKIMMING SONG chased the the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. BRITE CITY LIGHTS went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way into the lane. BIGTDAWG showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. MUSICAL TRICK lacked early foot, raced off the rail into the stretch and was not a factor. CLIPPER SHIP was void of early speed, saved ground into the lane and failed to menace.
