MICHAEL MYERS went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and held off the closing TWILIGHT MEMO to prevail. TWILIGHT MEMO chased the winner from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and was gaining on the winner late. SHAKIN SHAMUS chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. YOU CAN WIN was off slow, raced wide through the turn and showed some late run. COOKIN N BOOKIN was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. TIZ I IS lacked early foot, raced off the rail into the lane and was not a factor. DICEY DEAL showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
