Footnotes

TOUGH ROAD sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, increased that advantage into the lane and held sway to the wire. TATENATOR broke sharply to race just off the leaders from the inside, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished with a steady bid. CANTCATCHKATO chased the winner from the outside, was no match for that foe and gave way through the final furlong for the place. SPIKER showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, drifted inward at the eighth pole and finished with some late run from the inside. ALFONSO THE GREAT was fractious at the gate, raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly. WHATAQUAKE lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. T G'S JAZZ chased the leaders from the outside, weakened after going three furlongs and was eased through the lane.
