Footnotes

BEAULENA settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled out to continue the rally, swiftly reeled in BEST PRACTICES nearing the furlong marker and steadily drew away. DRIVING MISS SUSIE was allowed to settle, came four wide to launch her rally, but found her best stride too late. DASHING LADY dueled from the inside for the lead, drifted out and brushed PAPER CLIP leaving the three-sixteenths pole under left handed urging, and flattened out in the final yards. BEST PRACTICES pressed the pace racing three wide, forged command entering the stretch, but faltered during the drive and gave way. PAPER CLIP vied for the lead racing between horses, tired entering the lane, was brushed and steadied when DASHING LADY came out, and showed little thereafter. K D IMPLOSION was jostled at the start and never recovered. DEAR DEPUTY stalked the pace racing along the inside, bore out through the turn, was taken in hand and eased to the wire, but walked off. The trainer of PAPER CLIP lodged an objection against DASHING LADY for alleged interference in the upper stretch, but the Stewards found insufficient evidence to warrant a change to the order of finish.
