Footnotes

HE'S ALL HEART was away alertly to duel for the lead with TUCANNON from the outside, gained a slight edge on that rival nearing the three-quarter marker and kept him at bay to the wire. TUCANNON broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, responded when set down with a furlong to run but could not get by the winner in the drive. MAXIMUM PLEASURE lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and showed some late run. LAST TIME AROUND was rank to place early, chased the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. KING CONGO was never far back, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the eleven-sixteenths pole and gave way soon after. MISTER LICORICE showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. GARY THE GORILLA raced off the leaders from the inside and weakened into the lane.
