Footnotes

POLLY ESTER POMPOM was never far back, raced wide through the turn, responded to steady urging and wore down QUEEN SENSATION through the final yards. QUEEN SENSATION pressed the pace of ALTA'S FOREVER from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead into the stretch but could not resist the winner late. POINT DA HARBOR was void of early speed, raced off the rail through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with some late run. ALTA'S FOREVER was hustled along to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way into the lane. PARKER'S PROSPECT raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. GOLD TRICK broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. HEY LIL MISSY was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn, angled in nearing the quarter and was not a factor. SYMPHONY IN G showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
