**Footnotes**

PRETTY FUNNY HONEY sent clear at once, was collared three-eighths to home and dueled from there, gamely shook off PREMIUM PANTHER late and edged clear. PREMIUM PANTHER pressed the pace early, closed the gap and vied for the lead through the turn, held well to mid stretch but was turned away late. EMERALD LIGHT stalked the battling leaders on the inside, angled out leaving the turn, but lacked the needed late response. YOUNG COUNTRY STAR was unhurried early, made a middle move circling four wide on the turn, but flattened out late. CRACKLIN ROSIE stalked the pace on the outside, weakened in mid turn and steadily dropped back. FOGGY failed to respond. PERSIAN MOON stumbled at the start but was hustled along to stay close early, came up empty on the turn and stopped.
