FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Footnotes

THE GREAT FACE went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, turned back the tandem bid of COURTING SEATTLE and SPANISH HIGHWAY approaching the stretch, drifted out while increasing his advantage through the lane and held sway to the wire. DON'TWRITEMEOFF raced off the pacesetters from the inside, began to advance nearing the five-sixteenths marker, split foes nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. SCHOOLIN YOU was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good late speed. COURTING SEATTLE stalked the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. SPANISH HIGHWAY raced just off the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid with a quarter to run and gave way gradually in the drive. GERIRIG raced far back early and passed tiring foes late. ESCALANTE was away alertly to chase the leader from the inside for six furlongs and weakened. EXCLUSIVE EAGLE was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to rally. MR. MAKAH lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. SNORTER saved ground throughout to no avail.
