### Footnotes

IT'S OUR PLEASURE angled to the rail shortly after the start, began to commence a bid at the quarter, split foes in mid stretch and proved narrowly best in a stiff drive. TOUGH GOLD raced three wide into the first turn, pressed the pace from the outside, was four wide into the lane and finished willingly. GIANT'S BENCH stalked the pace off the rail, led in mid stretch and was outfinished by the top two. OUR DOUBLE O SEVEN was difficult to load, raced four wide into the first turn, allowed to settle into stride, swung five wide into the stretch and ran evenly late. MAUI AND ME hopped a bit at the start, was never far back and lacked a late response. WESTERN WHERE showed no rally. BUD E TEE was away alertly and opened up a clear advantage shortly after the start, maintained his lead into the stretch and tired. KASPARDASH hesitated at the start to be off a step behind the field and was always outrun.
