BUDDY DAVE stalked the leaders from the far outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter and drew clear through the lane. YES BAY showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole, moved between rivals late and finished with good energy. CASTLE ROMEO chased the leaders from the inside, angled out into the lane and finished with a late rally. COURTING SEATTLE chased the leaders from between foes, moved outside through the turn and gave way in the drive. BRAINSTORM raced off the leaders from between rivals, moved outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. SAINTLY I AIN'T sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going a half. INHOC SIGNO VINCAS lacked early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and failed to menace. CASTLE PINES raced off the leaders from between rivals and gradually weakened.
