Footnotes

HOOFPRIINTSINTIME showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the closing yards. STELLAR BLUE pressed the pace from between foes, moved up to offer a bid nearing the half, vied with FLYING JACK through a prolonged drive and just failed to last. BANDITONTHELOOSE broke sharply to set the early fractions, lugged out through the first turn, dropped back after going a half and came back from between rivals late to finish with good energy. FLYING JACK was away alertly to press the pace from the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and gave way grudgingly in the drive. GAME EMPEROR raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and lacked the needed late response. JUST JOKIN AROUND lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and lacked the needed rally.
