LIZZY LASS was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch, reached the leaders soon after and drew clear late. STOLEN FORUM raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, angled out further into the lane and finished with a steady rally. OUTING MAIL was off slow, saved ground through the turn, angled far out nearing the quarter and finished with good energy. UP YOUR PLAN broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final sixteenth. CEE THE LADY was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. CAHILL CUTIE was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the inside for a half, vied with UP YOUR PLAN into deep stretch and gave way. CIDER BURG chased the leaders from off the rail and gradually weakened after going a half. SKIMMING THE WAVE was bumped at the start, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
