Footnotes

BOLD WORDS well placed early while racing along the outside, was five-wide the final quarter mile and finished strongly to be up in the final strides. CRAFTY BOY saved ground while being allowed to settle in stride, steadied nearing the eighth pole lacking room, angled out when clear and finished strongly to just miss. ZANETTI saved ground stalking the pace, moved up along the outside to take the lead nearing the eighth pole, but wasn't quite good enough. RADAR CONTACT never far back, came four-wide into the stretch and was making up some ground late. EDNEATOR saved ground setting the pace while in hand, responded when challenged, but wasn't quite good enough. CROWNING MEETING allowed to settle early, split rivals during the drive and finished fairly well in an even effort. FIND OUR STAR unhurried early, came six-wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MOONLIGHT MEETING was three-wide throughout and was not a factor. AMERICAN JUSTICE unhurried early, came four-wide into the stretch and was not a factor. THETRUTHISOUTTHERE showed little in a dull effort. KOSLANIN (ARG) was finished early.
