PRIMO GIFT was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the seven-sixteenths marker and held sway to the wire. CANVASBACK COVE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, moved between foes in mid-stretch, came out to bump MUCHA MOOLA at the sixteenth pole and finished willingly to gain the place. NICK'S GOLD was never far back, saved ground throughout and lacked the needed late response. MUCHA MOOLA was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from between foes, was bumped nearing the sixteenth marker and continued to give way late. OLD MUSKET was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and found his best stride late. MR. BIG FIG was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside for a half and gave way. CRAZY JAY was slow to begin and did not reach contention.
