Footnotes

MORE WINE MON was off a step slow, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, moved up to reach the fore nearing the three-sixteenths pole, vied with BEST INDY WEST and drew clear of that rival through the closing yards. BEST INDY WEST showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, moved up to engage the winner in mid-stretch but could not match strides with that foe late. ONLY BE CAUSE lacked early speed, saved ground through the turns, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole but failed to sustain his rally in the drive. EMERALDS BOY chased a torrid pace from the outside for six furlongs and weakened. HIRED HAND broke sharply to chase the rapid pace from the inside and also weakened after going three-quarters. REVOLUTA sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting a ferocious pace, increased that margin after going a half and stopped after six furlongs.
