FIRST SYMPHONY pressed the pace racing two wide, wore down SHOW US RYAN following a prolonged drive, and gamely edged clear. SHOW US RYAN rushed to the lead to set the pressured pace, was unable to match strides with the winner, but dug in and was all out to hold the place. PALMETTO ROAD attend the pace racing along the inside, angled out entering the stretch to make a late rally, and was along in time to earn the show. T M MONSTROUS stalked the pace racing three deep, offered a mild bid entering the lane, but lacked a response when called upon. IRON CHEF was hustled along in mid pack racing two wide and went evenly. HE'S A BARN RAT was unhurried early, came three wide to make a belated gain, but was never a factor. MALOBOY broke a step slow, and saved ground to no avail thereafter.
