### Footnotes

TEMPLETON was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up take command with five-sixteenths to run and drew off through the lane. RHYTHM TO RUN lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with a solid late rally. QUAKER RUN chased the leaders from the outside and gave way gradually in the drive. KICKAPOLE raced off the leaders from the inside and failed to rally when called upon. WALLY BALLOU was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor. CLURMOR was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not offer a bid. IS THE BAR CLOSED broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going six furlongs.
