QUIETLY ROAR was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the quarter and held RUN TIN TIN at bay to the wire. RUN TIN TIN broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the inside, angled out into the stretch and was gaining on the winner late. SWISS S S T raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. OWHATABLAST lacked early speed, raced off the rail, into the lane and found her best stride late. ENDURING PAM showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. LITTLE TOWN FLIRT lacked early foot, saved ground into the stretch and did not menace. RARE BEAR pressed the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half. COLORFUL TUNE was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gradually weakened.
