**Footnotes**

AKINA was never far back, moved up from the outside to take command inside the three-eighths pole, maintained a slight edge into the lane, responded when challenged by GESCHE'S JOY and held that rival at bay through a prolonged drive. GESCHE'S JOY lacked early speed, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter but could not get by the winner in the drive. NINA WIN showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, reached a contending position into the lane but lacked the needed late response. DONT BE BUGGING ME broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the nine-sixteenths pole and gave way after going five furlongs. ALLISON RIDGE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gradually weakened.
