Footnotes

DIAMOND PEAK broke sharply to stalk the pace of IMA ROYAL PRINCE from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, reached the fore with a furlong to run and edged away from that rival through the closing yards. IMA ROYAL PRINCE sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by the winner in mid-stretch and gave way grudgingly to that rival late. WINGMAN WILLY raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and was gaining on the top pair late. TICHIT broke in, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn, reached a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. WHITE RIVER PIRATE hesitated at the break, raced off the rail into the stretch and found his best stride late. K P BRILLY raced off the pacesetters, moved outside through the turn, steadied nearing the three-sixteenths pole and did not threaten thereafter. SOCIALFUHR veered in at the start, was straightened away quickly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. RUSTY'S REVENGE broke a bit awkward, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
