### Footnotes

UNTIL YOU dueled for the lead from the outside throughout and gamely held to the wire. DARE ME DEVIL raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, responded to steady urging and was gaining on the winner late. EDGE FORWARD was never far back, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch, reached a contending position through the final yard but failed to gain late. HELLO FRANKIE was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the inside and gave way gradually in the drive. BELT broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes and gave way through the final furlong. PERFECT NIGHT showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and did not reach contention.
