MYSINCIRCUS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, reached the fore nearing the three-sixteenths marker and quickly drew off as a handy winner. SUNNY DRIVE was bumped at the start, duelled for the lead from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the half, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. GENTLEMAN'S RED broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter but failed to sustain her rally in the drive. RAISE THE ANTE was off a step slow, raced wide through second turn, could not gain on the top three but was the best of the rest. SOVEREIGN BAY was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, angled out approaching the stretch and did not reach contention. CHIPS INDY SALSA broke slow and outward, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. ROXO was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half.
