CHESTNUT LADY went to the front soon after the start, set a pressured pace into the lane, responded when challenged with a quarter to run, drifted in nearing the sixteenth pole and drew off steadily late. CARRIE WITH A C broke awkwardly and was bumped, pressed the pace from the inside, offered a bid inside the quarter, steadied when winner came in nearing the sixteenth marker, altered course and finished willingly. MATTY G WHIZ was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside, offered a bid nearing the quarter pole but could not stay with the winner in the drive. AWESOME GIRL was never far back while racing from the outside, moved up to engage nearing the quarter and failed to sustain her rally. LIBERTY WAY broke out to bump rival, raced off the rail throughout and finished evenly. TOO CUTE TO BOOT showed brief speed and weakened. FOR THE GIRLS was bumped at the start, raced off the rail into the stretch and did not reach contention. BOUNTY'S BABY broke slow and was bumped and failed to threaten. The rider of CARRIE WITH A C lodged an objection against the winner concerning the drifted in nearing the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films the Stewards made no change.
