HILLBILLY CADILLAC broke in, raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch, reached his stable-mate with a sixteenth to run and was going away late. TATENATOR was never far back while racing from off the rail, angled out with a furlong to run and finished with good energy. HUSLYN CAT dueled for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear lead nearing the five-sixteenths pole, increased that margin in mid-stretch and gave way through the final yards. PROUD COZZENE was off a step slow, raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and finished with some late run. SPIKER was pushed inward at the start, raced off the rail into the stretch and failed to menace. CANTCATCHKATO broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way after going five furlongs. LOCK ME UP was off a step slow, saved ground and lagged throughout.
