Footnotes

PERFECT FINISH was away alertly to stalk the pace of SNOWBOUND MARQUITA from the outside, responded to steady urging and wore that rival down through the final yards. SNOWBOUND MARQUITA broke sharply to set a pressured pace, opened a clear lead nearing the quarter, increased that margin in mid-stretch but could not resist the winner late. SHAMEONYA was never far back, raced far wide through the turn and finished evenly late. STRATEGIC PATIENCE was off a step slow, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the quarter and finished full of run. GHOST TREE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. OUTING MAIL raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and failed to rally. ALL THE RAGE chased the leaders from the outside for a half and weakened.
