DAVE'S PACEMAKER stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage TUCANNON into the lane, drifted in and bumped with that rival through the final sixteenth and proved best in a stiff drive. TUCANNON was bumped at the start, dueled for the early advantage with VICKYS FAST BOY from the outside, gained a slight edge with a quarter to run, bumped with the winner through the final yards and just missed. MUD STOMPER was never far back while racing from off the rail, could not gain on the leaders in the drive but held on well to save the show. KACTUS RELEVATION showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and showed some late interest. BORN'N BLUE GENES was off slow, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. VICKYS FAST BOY broke awkwardly, recovered quickly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way after going a half. SUGAR PLAYAH raced off the pacesetters from the outside and failed to threaten. The rider of TUCANNON lodged an objection against DAVE'S PACEMAKER concerning the bumping incident through the final sixteenth and after reviewing the films the Stewards made no change.
