### Footnotes

HE'S TICKLED sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and held off the closing BEBE CHRISSEY in the drive to prevail. BEBE CHRISSEY was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch and was steadily gaining on the winner late. TANEUM CANYON raced off the pacesetters throughout and failed to menace. JAMES was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. J. T. ROCKS lagged far back early and did not reach contention. G TEN was off a step slow, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor.
