CRESCENT MCGAIN broke awkwardly, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the quarter, responded to steady encouragement and finished with a late surge to be up in the final strides. IM PURE BRASS broke in, moved up quickly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin into the lane but could not resist the winner late. ADRIATIC PRINC was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside, could not reach the top pair in the drive but finished with good energy. GEARING UP was shuffled back at the start, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a late bid. WINORBEGONE dueled for the lead from the outside and weakened through the final furlong. MOVE ON OVER lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. SEVENTEENMILEDRIVE pressed the pace from between foes for a half and weakened.
