SISTER ADIBA never far back, came two-wide into the stretch, split rivals during the drive and was up in the final seventy yards. NORTHERN VENTURE saved ground setting the pace in hand, responded when asked, but wasn't quite able to resist the winner late. CLEVER COED saved ground while being unhurried, angled out four-wide entering the stretch and finished strongly. PLAYDEMROCKS prompted the issue racing three-wide, but lacked a rally. OKANAGAN INVADER saved ground stalking the pace, but lacked a rally when called upon. MIZ HEATHER showed little. PACIFIC REIGN dropped back early while racing wide, gave way badly after six furlongs, was eased late and walked off.
