IT'S OUR PLEASURE stalked the pace of TOP BANKER AL from the inside, moved up from the outside to gain a slight edge nearing the three-sixteenths pole and edged clear late. TOP BANKER AL sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the drive. SMOKEY M J lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. PHINNEY RIDGE showed no early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and also finished with late interest. REGAL JOURNEY broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened.
